

The first person to reach the top of Chimborazo and the bottom of the Challenger Deep is Vanessa O'Brien (UK/USA), who summitted Chimborazo on 6 June 2016 and descended to the Challenger Deep on 12 June 2020. O'Brien visited both extremes within a time of 4 years 7 days.



Farthest mountain peak from Earth's centre



Chimborazo. It is 6,310 m (20,702 ft) high, and lies 158 km (98 miles) south of the equator in Ecuador. Its summit is 2,150 m (7,054 ft) further from the Earth's centre than the summit of Mt Everest, since the Earth's radius in Ecuador is longer than the radius at the latitude of Mt Everest.
