A basic genealogical record per name (bold items engraved):

- **First and last names of Polish-born emigrants. To keep couples together use married surname and née maiden name for wife. A couple is two donations and should be added separately.**
- Date / place of birth in Poland (name of place at time of birth) or town emigrated from in Poland,
- **Year of emigration (if known),**
- Place of settlement in the US (if known), and
- Name of the relative or sponsor of the entry.
- Information not engraved will be recorded in a digital Book of Gratitude 2026, accessible and downloadable from our website.
